

CHAPTER 8

SCOPE AND SUGGESTIONS

After the study of the Grove, these are the suggestions to save the biodiversity of the area which are as follows.

1. Uncontrolled grazing by domestic livestock should be banned in the core areas of the grove in order to ensure regeneration of biota in grazing portions.
2. Sufficient forest staff should be employed. At present there are 9 members of the forest staff, they must be doubled, and their duties should be well defined. Here the recruitment of honest, educated, young, encouraging, hardworking and energetic staff is required.
3. There is not enough water throughout the year for wildlife. Renewal of natural water resources is required, to meet the requirement of water. Natural water sources of the area should be deepened, they should also be repaired.
4. In this area, poaching should be completely banned, and if a hunter is caught they should be punished with a strict punishment.
5. One Jeep and two bikes should be given to forest staff for regular and effective patrolling.
6. The government should provide basic medical aid for wildlife.
7. The mining plant running near the grove should be closed completely.
8. Checkpoints should be established at the sensitive points of the grove and the traditional hunting communities residing in the vicinity of the grove area should be surveyed and listed out.
9. LPG connections and solar cookers should be given at low rate to local villagers, this will reduce the amount of firewood taken from the grove.
10. Government should make the plantation in the grove regularly with the help of locals.

11. Encroachment is the serious growing problem of the area, government should take strict action against this and the boundary marks should be constructed around the park.
12. The boundaries of the grove should be monitored regularly.
13. In Charanwas, Gudhameena, Kishanpura and Charangarh villages, there is a need to create barriers to prevent soil erosion during rain.
14. Some shallow wells should be constructed in the area to conserve the rain water and improve the ground water level.
15. The use of plastic bags should be strictly prohibited in the park.
16. Proper sign boards should be put up in the grove to give details of flora, fauna and the history of the area.
17. Drinking water facilities for wildlife in the summer season should be increased.
18. Illegal activities of local people like herb collection, mining, firewood and timber collection, grazing, encroachment, and pollution in the area should be strictly banned.
19. The use of loudspeakers should be completely stopped.
20. The water resources of the grove for washing, bathing and other personal purposes should be prohibited.
21. Use of the grove as picnic spot in sustainable manner may be encouraged.
22. In order to save the biodiversity of the grove, the local people must keep the religious beliefs associated with it alive.
23. Government and other organizations should organize the programmes related to nature conservation, pollution control, environmental education and awareness, sustainable development, plantation, biodiversity & wildlife conservation.
24. Educate people about the importance of nature and natural resources to the existence of life on earth and the benefits of sustainable utilization of nature and natural resources.
25. A door to door survey of nearby villages to know that how they are utilizing the natural resources of the area and encouraging people for adopting sustainable utilization of natural resources.

26. The locals will have to get back to the sacredness and religious beliefs of the grove.
27. The government should run a special campaign to reduce the illiteracy and poverty in the region, along with other organizations.
28. Unauthorized use of medicinal plants found in the area should be banned.
29. Female members should be included in forest staff.
30. Forest staff must be honest to obey their duties and don't support their relatives in illegal activities.
31. Forest staff members should have to behave fully professionally at the time of duty.
32. A Government should arrange accommodation and weapons in the grove area for forest staff.
33. At the time of fair, the government should make proper arrangements to reduce environmental pollution and waste.
34. Waste food and other waste material should be disposed of properly.
