## **4. AIM & OBJECTIVES**

### **AIM:**

The aim of the study is to carry out safety surveillance of ADRs in patients on haemodialysis and study its impact on improving pharmacovigilance practices.

### **OBJECTIVES:**

The specific objectives of the study are:

1. To study the awareness among HCPs regarding pharmacovigilance and to devise strategies to bring out awareness on ADRs among HCPs in order to improve existing pharmacovigilance practices.
2. To study the awareness among consumers/patients regarding pharmacovigilance and devise strategies to promote direct patient reporting.
3. To carry out ADR monitoring in patients on haemodialysis at AIIMS.
  - To design and introduce a suspected ADR case report form.
  - To analyze and assess the pattern of observed ADRs.
  - To determine the incidence of ADRs in patients on haemodialysis in Nephrology department at AIIMS.
  - To investigate therapeutic drug classes commonly used in human concerning the major frequency of ADR.
