

ABSTRACT

Present study titled ‘**A Study of Personality Traits in Female Students of Professional and Non Professional Institutions of Allahabad District**’ was conducted on students of non-Professional and Professional students of Allahabad district. This study is a comparative study of 16 personality factors. Descriptive survey method was used for data collection. Sample of the study was 500 female students studying in Professional and Non Professional Institutions of Allahabad district. Multistage sampling method was used for sampling. 16 Personality factors: warmth, reasoning, emotional stability, dominance, liveliness, rule-conscious, social boldness, sensitivity, suspicious, abstractedness, privateness, apprehension, openness to change, self-reliance, self sentiment, tension are used in this test. This is cattell’s 16 personality test was constructed by S.D Kapoor. The salient findings of the study were: (1.) Group of Professional Institutions of female students of final year score high in all the factors A,B,C,E,F,G,H,I,L,M,N,O,Q1,Q2,Q3,Q4.than the group of Professional first year female students. (2.) There is significant difference is found in personality traits of Non Professional female students in first and final year. (3.) There is significant difference found in Non Professional and Professional first year students. They are equally practical in 14 factors B,C,E,F,G,H,I,L,M,O,Q1,Q2,Q3,Q4.out of 16 factors. (4) There is significant difference is found in Professional and Non Professional final year female students on 13 factors(A,B, C, E, F, G, H, I, L, M, O, Q3, Q4,). Non Professional female students are differing not significantly in 3 factors (N, Q1, and Q2) out of 16 personality factors.
